This past year was the first time that our youth program offered students a Career Exploration Internship opportunity. This internship was designed for students to work with UUUM staff members in order to learn professional skills they can take with them to college and beyond.

We are grateful for the work done by our four 2023-2024 Career Exploration Interns, Funmi, Sabrina, Sofia, and Sarah-Simone. Amongst their many accomplishments, our interns:

- Helped redesign our <u>Seeing Me in the World</u> program, making it an experience for youth, by youth
- Created the first sections of the <u>Examining Our History</u> section of the UUUM website, that looks at slavery as it relates to the history of First Church Roxbury
- Assisted with the curation of a tour of the Meetinghouse that examines the true history of First Church Roxbury that will be offered soon

Sophie and Carlie have both been Learning Artists this year, and in these videos share a little about their experiences and what they've learned.



A big thank you to the folks who joined us to get our peace garden ready for summer. As you can see, our **Green Team** did a bang up job...and we are grateful!








Restoring Roxbury's Meetinghouse

The Return of the Historic Organ




The Meetinghouse's historic Hook & Hastings organ was removed during the early stages of the interior renovation. Thanks to a generous donor, the organ was disassembled and sent to Connecticut to be fully restored.

Now as we reach the final stages of work, the work of putting it back together has begun. The plywood that has covered the organ's home was recently removed, and the wood frame is being put back in place.




A closer look at the wood frame of the Meetinghouse's Hook & Hastings organ.
